



November Project: Conserving Virginia's Natural Resources

What: Because we have been studying Virginia's natural resources in science, the November project will be to make a poster urging people to help conserve one of Virginia's natural resources. A paragraph about that natural resource and its conservation needs to be included.

When: This project will run from October 31st through November 30th - Please make sure all posters are handed in on **Wednesday, November 30th**. DO NOT wait till the last minute to work on your project. Leave yourself enough time to do a good job!!!

How: Make sure to complete both 1 and 2 for your project.

1. While making your poster, please include the following information:

- ~ Pick one natural resource from Virginia
- ~ Make sure your poster clearly shows how we can conserve that natural resource (you can include more than one way to conserve)
- ~ Find information on that source and how to conserve it.

2. You also must include a paragraph about the resource. The paragraph can be written on the back of the poster or on another sheet of paper. Make sure your paragraph has details and is grammatically correct. Use your textbook, notes, and any other sources to get your information. DO NOT try to write the paragraph from memory. Please include:

- ~ Name of your natural resource.
- ~Where is the resource found in Virginia?
- ~Why is the resource important to Virginians?
- ~How is the resource wasted, polluted, or overly used?
- ~How can we conserve the resource?
