This project is for all you sports lovers out there! As the summer ends and the weather gets cooler, a lot of students turn their attention to their favorite sports teams and events!

What: Create a poster to show your team's season schedule. You may use any method of showing the schedule that you want. You can use a chart or be creative! Make sure your poster is clear as they will be hanging in the hallway and others will want to read them!

You **must** include:

1. The date of the event
2. The opponent
3. The place the event will be played
4. The latitude and longitude of the city the event will be played
5. The distance to travel to that place
6. Facts about the players on your team
7. Statistics about the team

When: This project will run from **September 14th** – **October 9th**. Don't wait until the last minute! Your best work will take some time!

Materials Needed: Posterboard (22' by 28' standard size), your favorite sports team schedule, a computer or atlas to look up latitude and longitude (students that use an atlas can estimate the lat./long.), books or website with info. about your team

Date	Opponent	Game Location	Latitude/Longitude	Travel Distance
Sat. Jan. 2 nd	Pittsburgh	Syracuse, NY	43N' 76W	0 miles
Wed. Jan. 13	West Virginia	Morgantown, WV	39N' 79W	7 hours 12 minutes
Mon. Jan. 18	Notre Dame	South Bend, IN	41N' 86W	9 hours 39 minutes
